Science Week



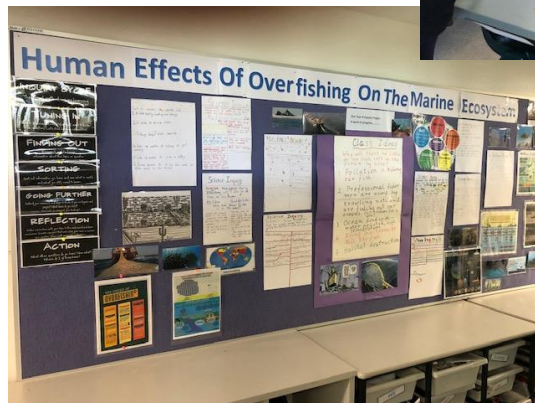
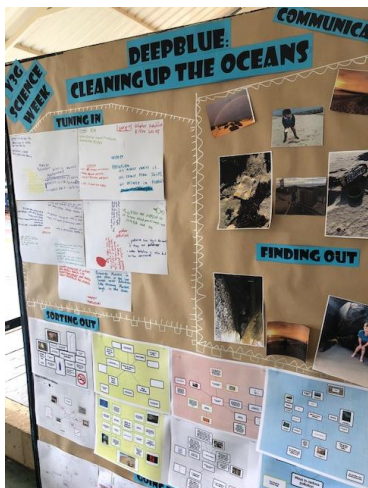
