








What are we trying to do?


- The future of Floreat Park Primary School is strong – we will continue to be a school of choice and enrolments will grow.
- Without proper planning we will reach an accommodation crisis point and the answer will be ad hoc development compromising our existing facilities.
- A Grounds and Facilities Strategy will give us a set of guiding and prioritised principles for development, an agreed future vision.
- These principles will form the backdrop to ongoing discussions with local, state, federal governments and external funding groups for capital allocations.
- Importantly, they will also guide P&C spending from our generous school community.
- While we are not the only decision-makers, we are crucial to the decision-making process – this Strategy will be our united voice.
- We aim to work proactively and constructively with the decision-makers to ensure all outcomes are in the best interests of our school community and our children.



What's happened to date




Buildings: 2016 Term 3 and 4



- One new ECE transportable on-site now.
- Three others to be moved ready for build, over Term 3 holiday period.
- Probable length of time taken 4 working weeks.




Buildings: 2017 Early Childhood Centre



- May 2016: Floreat Park PS receives funding for a four room Early Childhood Classroom building.
- June 2016: First Transportable placed on oval
- October 2016: Three ECE Transportables repositioned onto school oval
- 2017 New four classroom Early Childhood Education building commenced.



Buildings: Now and The Future



- 2016 – 20 classes onsite
- 2017 – 22 classes onsite, 2 more transportables
- 2018 and beyond – Department of Education figures predict population to continue to grow to 730 in 2020. This scenario would require an additional 4 transportable rooms on site.
- Positioning of buildings onsite for 2017 and beyond does not indicate actual intent.
