The first group were presented with their certificates last Friday by our own Ninja Warrior, ex-student Ben Polson. Next week they will participate in Activity Week; three days of activities incorporating community service, culture and fun.

Thank you to those parents who responded to our parent survey. We had 90 responses across all year levels. The information will be analysed a school and Board level before we determine possible actions.

Another opportunity for parents to provide feedback as well as gain some insights into what we are planning for next year, is through a series of year level parent meetings. We conducted meetings last year and feedback was that they were useful to parents. Their purpose is to provide parents with class structures for the following year, discuss learning opportunities and any special programs we will be running and elicit feedback on their experiences this year. Well done, well done, well done! Thank you to Floreat Park Primary School Community for supporting the walk or ride to school day.



# IMPORTANT CHANGE TO SCHOOL COMMUNICATION - ABSENCES

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Starting this Monday, we implemented a service called Outreach+. The SMS service is managed by the Department of Education and will automatically text the primary contact mobile number on our system if your child is marked with an unexplained absence on our morning school roll.

To avoid receiving a message, we ask that you notify us of your child's absence before 9:00am. At 10:00am if your child is marked with an unexplained absence, you will receive the following text message from school:

Floreat Park Primary School records show [name] is absent , . Pls reply SMS stu name/reason/abs date

If no reason is received another message will be sent:

Floreat Park Primary School records show NO REASON GIVEN for the absence of [name] on , . Pls reply SMS stu name/reason/abs date

The preferred method of informing us of student absence is now via text message to the following number 0447 883 414. You may choose to add this number to your phone contacts for future reference.

This is an SMS only number which has been allocated to our school by the Department and linked to Outreach+. We will eventually phase out Flexibuzz and the school website as a method of reporting absence.

Outreach+ helps improve our safeguarding practices and is also part of our aim to streamline and improve communication with parents.
